**PAYMENT:**

You can pay for classes by mail, in person during office hours or by telephone with a credit card. We accept Visa, MasterCard, Diners Club and American Express. Payment is due when you register. If your check is returned for insufficient funds, your registration will be cancelled until you pay the amount due, plus a \$20 fee.

**REFUNDS:**

It is the policy of Seattle Parks and Recreation and the Associated Recreation Council that: Anyone who registers for a class, camp, event or program that is cancelled for any reason by Seattle Parks and Recreation or Associated Recreation Council will receive a full refund.

Anyone registered for a program who requests a refund before the second class session will receive a prorated refund minus a service charge of 10%. A service charge of 10% will be assessed to those who have enrolled in a boating program do not pass the required float test. We recommend that anyone who has any doubts about their swimming ability should take the float test prior to enrolling.
